

Report Title:	Specification for Primary Care for the provision of physical health checks for adults with serious mental illness.

Summary

The Mental Health Investment Plan has identified funding (£200k pa) to support the delivery of physical health checks for adults with serious mental illness.

A Business Case has been developed along with a specification for provision of a comprehensive physical health check in Primary Care.

Reporting of coverage of the physical health check is part of the Integrated Assessment Framework

The preferred option for the provision of this programme is as a Locally Commissioned Service Contract with Primary Care.

A specification has been developed. This identifies a key performance indicator to achieve a minimum 60% coverage rate for the physical health check across Primary Care. A payment of £80 per health check is proposed, with an incentive payment of 10% for achieving a coverage above the 60% rate

The specification has been reviewed by the Clinical Reference Group in August. Comments were made regarding the payment structure and the reporting requirement for Primary Care. These amendments have been incorporated into the specification attached.

The intention is to start to provide the physical health check programme from January 2020.

Recommendation to Primary Care Commissioning Committee.

The Primary Care Commissioning Committee is requested to comment on and support the specification.
