Target Audience: This course is suitable for Practice Nurses who are either just getting started in Primary Care or are looking to develop expertise in Type 2 Diabetes. Please note: The funding for this course has been ringfenced nationally for specific roles – All Registered Nurses, Nurse Associates, Paramedics and Physiotherapists

Course Aim: This course aims to influence and change your diabetes practice in relation to the diagnosis, assessment and management of Type 2 Diabetes (and its known cardiovascular consequences) by increasing your knowledge and practical skills.

Learning Objectives: Upon successful completion of the course delegates be better able to:

- Define Type 2 Diabetes and discuss how it differs from Pre-Diabetes and Type 1 Diabetes
- Identify individuals' risk of developing T2DM
- Demonstrate knowledge of the available tests for diagnosis of T2DM
- Demonstrate knowledge of the diagnostic criteria for T2DM
- Demonstrate knowledge of the known pathological defects associated with T2DM and link these to specific pharmacotherapies
- Identify persons at risk of micro and macro vascular complications and implement interventions and strategies known to reduce risk
- Demonstrate knowledge of and diagnostic criteria for known common comorbidities associated with T2DM
- Discuss the care pathway, including therapy optimisation for individuals diagnosed with T2DM in accordance with National and Local Guidelines
- Promote the safe and effective use of anti-diabetes medications
- Support the person to self-care for their T2DM
