

## **Trainee Nursing** Associate (TNA)

Intake Spring 2024

With the University of Salford and University of Bolton





Places are open to any new or existing staff within your Primary Care Network (PCN) or General Practice. The Nursing Associate is a new support role in England that bridges the gap between healthcare support workers and registered nurses to deliver hands-on, person-centred care as part of the nursing team.



- Employers can apply for a levy transfer to cover the cost of the course fee's (15,000)
- For each TNA, employers will be eligible for a total funding sum of £8,000 over 2 years.
- PCN's have the option to utilise ARRS funding to cover the TNA salary

Candidates must have the support of their employer, must have maths and English GCSE C or above (4-9) or level 2 functional skills and be employed for at least 30 hours per week. (Applicants must also meet all the university and apprenticeship requirements).
