## Funding

- Apprenticeships are funded through the apprenticeship levy.
- Larger organisations utilise their own levy funding, where they have this in place.
- The Government support 95% of the apprenticeship costs where no levy is in place with the employer.
- Levy transfers are available and can often be accessed.

## Levels of Apprenticeships

Intermediate

### Equivalent to GCSE

Level 2 apprentices follow work-based learning towards a level 2 equivalent to 5 GCSEs at grades 9-4 (A\*-C). These apprenticeships provide the skills needed for the chosen career and allow entry to an advanced level apprenticeship.

Advanced

### Equivalent to A-Level

Level 3 follow work-based learning towards level 3 – equivalent to 2 A-levels. To start this level of apprenticeship, you should ideally have 5 GCSEs (grade 4/C or above) or have completed an intermediate level apprenticeship.

Higher

### Equivalent to Foundation degree and above

Higher level apprentices follow work-based learning towards Levels 4,5,6 and 7, which is equivalent to a foundation degree and above. To start this level of apprenticeship, you should ideally have two A-levels (or equivalent) or have completed an advanced level apprenticeship.

Degree

### Equivalent to Bachelor's or Master's degree

Degree level apprenticeships follow work-based learning towards Levels 6 and 7, which is equivalent to a full bachelor's or master's degree.
