


Funding

- Apprenticeships are funded through the apprenticeship levy.
- Larger organisations utilise their own levy funding, where they have this in place.
- The Government support 95% of the apprenticeship costs where no levy is in place with the employer.
- Levy transfers are available and can often be accessed.

Levels of Apprenticeships



Equivalent to Bachelor's or Master's degree Degree level apprenticeships follow work-based learning towards Levels 6 and 7, which is

equivalent to a full bachelor's or master's degree.
