

# CPD Training for Primary Care Nurses and AHPs

## Understanding Triage Methodologies, Patient Prioritisation & Care Pathways - University of Bolton

The aim of this module is to provide you with the knowledge required to utilise triage processes and decision-making theories to assess the urgency of patients' needs and apply principles of prioritisation and the identification of red flags.

There are **no essays** or written exams. Instead, you'll complete a **presentation-based assessment**, allowing you to demonstrate clinical insight, evidence-based reasoning, and communication skills without the pressure of formal academic writing

### Module Learning Outcomes:

- Demonstrate a critical understanding of triage methods and the differences between them.
- Critically analyse patient centred decision-making using evidence-based practice and local and national policy and guidelines.
- Synthesise and critique the importance of effective consultation skills and communication to the patient and multi-disciplinary team.
