Mastalgia in Primary Care

Thank you all for your continued support with managing patients with mastalgia in primary care. By providing advice in management of such symptoms and offering reassurance you have made a significant difference to the number of patients referred with breast pain.

A recent audit in Bolton has shown a reduction of referrals from 20% to 8.6% of patients with persistent mastalgia. A similar audit was conducted at Manchester University NHS Foundation Trust (WTWA) which demonstrated a referral rate of 8.5% of patients with a single symptom of breast pain down from 21%

Teledermatology

Work continues on a model and specification of a GM Model of Care for dermatology. As part of this work a teledermatology model, which incorporates advice and guidance, has also been developed. This has been reviewed by the working groups that contributed to its development. The models are being presented this month to various GM Boards and, should they be approved, implementation work will begin shortly thereafter. Further updates and training opportunities specific to dermatology will be provided.

False negative chest x-rays – reminder for a 2ww suspected lung cancer referral

23% of lung cancers do not show up on chest x-rays. If a patient's chest x-ray is normal but symptoms persist, consider referring for a 2ww lung cancer referral.

There are GM resources which support diagnosis of lung cancer.
