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

Admissions avoidance

Referral directly from GP, ANP, OP clinic Consultant, podiatrist Secondary care ED, AMU, ACU, short stay acute






Referrals from secondary care

- Secondary care referral>48 hours: early discharge
 - more complex patients
 - Existing microbiologist input
 - Secondary care follow up





Core conditions

- Cellulitis/soft tissue infection/Surgical site
- UTI/ESBL UTI
- Chest infection
- Bronchiectasis
- Diabetic foot infection
- Osteomyelitis
- Leg ulcer





Exclusion criteria

- <18years
- Pregnant/breastfeeding
- Haemodynamically unstable
- Unable to obtain consent
- Homeless
- IVDU





Core conditions: Selection of Antibiotics

- Regimes have been agreed with medical microbiologists
- Once daily regimes initially
- Step down to oral therapy as soon as appropriate





Referrals: Core hours 0800-1900hrs

- Members of BSAC


